HHYC Mooring in Oyster Bay, Long Island

Location: N 40 degrees and 52 min and 45 sec or .754/1000

W 73 degrees and 30 min and 47 sec or .795/1000

As you can see below, this mooring differs from our HHYC moorings. It has a 3 foot vertical PVC pipe standing on a large white ball, marked with the letters "HH". There is a short rope at the top of the pipe. There is no bridle.

Securing your boat to the mooring:

- Arrive at the mooring with at least one dock line secured to one of your bow cleats. If your dock line has a loop, secure the loop end to your cleat as it may not fit through the small loop at the top of the pipe on the mooring.
- Run your dock line through the loop on top of the mooring and back to the same bow cleat.
- Run a second dock line from your other bow cleat, through the mooring loop and back to the same cleat.

Remember:

- DO NOT attempt to secure the mooring loop directly to your boat, use dock lines.
- Each dock line should originate from, and terminate at, the <u>same</u> cleat, otherwise the constant boat movement will cause the loop and line to chafe.
